

## Symposium 2024 March 5 & 6, 2024 Subsidize-a-Student Program

Dear fellow textile community member,

Student's interest in textiles is critical for the future of the Canadian textile industry. To encourage students in material science, polymers, and engineering disciplines as well as those in the traditional textile streams to participate in our Symposium, the Institute has established the Subsidize-a-Student Program.

The normal registration fee for students for the Symposium is CDN\$70 per day. Individuals or organizations can subsidize one or more student registrations by contributing CDN\$50 so that students only have to pay CDN\$20 per day to attend the Symposium.

Students enrolled in undergraduate or graduate programs in universities, colleges, CEGEPs, and doing internships in research organizations are eligible.
